

Vice President of Operations

PRINCIPLE RESPONSIBILTIES:

- 2. <u>Improve Supply Chain Management:</u> Lead the shift of the company's supply chain strategy and processes to a strategic buying concept.
- 3. <u>Improve Flow:</u> The Company is moving to a new, significantly larger, facility in Summer 2018. The VP Operations will be responsible for optimizing the overall material and manufacturing flow within the new facility to support the company's growth and increase efficiencies.
- 4. <u>Management by Metrics:</u> Develop and implement a metrics-based approach to Operations in order to achieve continuous improvement.
- 5. **ERP System Integration:** Ensure proper integration of the new Microsoft D365 ERP system throughout the operations and improve accuracy and reporting of metrics within the system.
- 6. <u>Organizational Development:</u> Develop the organization to its full potential and keep personnel motivated and productive.
- 7. **Collaboration:** The VP Operations will work close with the rest of the leadership team at the company, as well as with the teams within the Engineering and Sales organizations.

BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE:
